TRAFFIC ON QUERNMORE ROAD - The January Parish Council heard about residents' concerns about the traffic on Quernmore Road - the amount of vehicles and the speed at which they travel. The number of cars and lorries has increased since the Bay Gateway opened. Many pay no attention to the 30mph limit. The Parish Clerk will contact Lancashire Highways to ask about reducing the speed limit, or at least enforcing the existing limit. Councillors will deploy the Speed Indicating Device (SpID) on Quernmore Road to alert drivers to their speed.

INFORMATION BOARD - There is an information board about the villages on the wall by the post box at the mini roundabout in Caton. Some of the information on the board is out-of-date. Would you volunteer to have a fresh look at this board and suggest how it could be improved? Several people - or a group - could work on it together to come up with new wording and graphics. The Parish Council could then help find grants to have a new board created and put up. Please contact Jenny Walmsley in the first instance on 771299.

SYCAMORE ROAD - Lancashire Highways and the developers are looking at resurfacing work needed now the housing development is nearing completion.

DRAINS AND ROADS - Lancashire Highways have been working on Littledale Road, where some resurfacing has been done, and on Moorside Road, where they have tackled a blocked culvert.

PARISH PRECEPT - We all pay towards the work of the Parish Council, through our local rates. Most of the spending goes on supporting the Victoria Institute, parish maintenance (including the Play Park, bus shelters, benches, War Memorial and the car parks), insurance and paying the Parish Clerk. This year we are increasing the precept by 4%, which is about £1.20 extra a year for a typical Band D property. The full budget will be added to the village website, or you can ask the Parish Clerk for a copy. We will continue to pressurise Lancaster City Council and Lancashire County Council to do what they should to keep our streets and pavements in good order, and to clean the Millennium Way. However we can all help keep the villages and the surrounding countryside tidy - simple things like picking up litter and clearing weeds outside your home really do make a difference.

EXTENSION OF THE MILLENNIUM WAY - Sustrans are working on proposals to extend the Millennium Way towards Claughton and ultimately to Wray. You can see a copy of their ideas in a document which we have left at the Victoria Institute. We'll let you know what develops.

VANDALISM AND ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR in the villages continues to cause problems for many of us. Please do report everything to the police. The Parish Council hopes to have a police representative at the Annual Parish Meeting in May.

PARISH COUNCIL MEETING Tuesday 11 February at 7.15pm in the Victoria Institute. There is an Open Forum at the start of the meeting where residents are welcome to raise matters of local concern.



LUNE VALLEY SWIFTS

Last summer the group put in over 100 volunteer hours to identify at least 30 different swift nest sites in Caton and Brookhouse, showing that the area is still a stronghold for swifts. Our mission is to protect these amazing birds by raising awareness and putting up more swift nest boxes. Swifts are only with us for about three months each summer. At the moment they will be enjoying the warmth of east Africa having migrated there in August/September! They will return to us to breed in May and need plenty of nest sites to arrive back to.

In 2020, with the help of a grant from Champion Bowland, we'll be putting up demonstration swift boxes on community buildings in the parish and trying to encourage as many residents as possible to do the same.

If you think you may have swifts nesting in your property it is very important to protect any existing nest sites - they may have been used by the same pair of birds for many years. 
