VANDALISM - In recent months people in all parts of the villages have suffered anti-social behaviour, vandalism and damage to cars. The police tell us that the first step should always be to report the problem to them, and to get an incident number. Even if they don't attend, having a report allows them to build up a picture and perhaps to patrol more frequently. If you can take photos of the offenders, so much the better. The Parish Council has already complained to the Police Commissioner for Lancashire about the lack of a police presence in the rural areas, and we have been told that more staff will be allocated to the Lune Valley. Meanwhile, keep reporting to the Police!

DRAINS - Lancashire Highways were out in the villages in late November and cleaned out some drains thoroughly. As ever, the message is to keep reporting problems with blocked drains, potholes and other problems on the roads to Lancashire Highways.

PARISH COUNCIL MEETING - The next Parish Council meeting is on Tuesday 14 January 2020 at 7.15pm in the Victoria Institute. At the start of the meeting there is an Open Forum when residents can raise issues of local concern.

DEFIBRILLATOR - The defibrillator at St Paul's School has now been installed and is ready for use. Suitable for adults and children. If it is needed for an emergency instructions will be given automatically by the equipment. However training sessions will be organised in the spring.

ALBANIA EARTHQUAKE APPEAL

On 26th November my wife, Ruth, and I were in Albania and experienced a 6.4 magnitude earthquake which caused devastation. 51 people were killed, approximately 2000 people injured and 4000 people made homeless. LUNE VALLEY SWIFTS

Last summer the group put in over 100 volunteer hours to identify at least 30 different swift nest sites in Caton and Brookhouse, showing that the area is still a stronghold for swifts. Our mission is to protect these amazing birds by raising awareness and putting up more swift nest boxes.

Swifts are only with us for about three months each summer. At the moment they will be enjoying the warmth of east Africa having migrated there in August/September! They will return to us to breed in May and need plenty of nest sites to arrive back to.

In 2020, with the help of a grant from Champion Bowland, we'll be putting up demonstration swift boxes on community buildings in the parish and trying to encourage as many residents as possible to do the same.

Our next meeting is at 7.30pm on 12th February at The Station, Caton. Look out for more info about our meetings and events this year in the LINK.

If you think you may have swifts nesting in your property it is very important to protect any existing nest sites - they may have been used by the same pair of birds for many years. This is particularly important if you are having any work done on your house. We can provide advice to help you. Or would you like to instal a swift nest box ready for the nesting season? Or just join our friendly group to help out and be part of something positive to help wildlife?
