VICTORIA INSTITUTE

The Victoria Institute remains closed, due to the Coronavirus pandemic. The Council of Management is awaiting further information and instruction from the Government, regarding the easing of the lockdown, before any decision can be made concerning reopening of the Institute. The Trustees are looking forward to the time, when the many regular groups and customers, can return to the Victoria Institute. The Council of Management continues to hold its monthly meetings using 'Zoom' to conduct the business of running the Institute.

Two Swift boxes have been fitted to the front of the Institute, thanks to the Lune Valley Swift Group. We are hope that boxes will be occupied in the not too distant future.

During this time, Peter Collins (the Community Support Worker), is coordinating the efforts, on behalf of the Community Pandemic Support Group, to provide help and support to the residents of Caton with Littledale and North Quernmore and in some cases Hornby & Halton.

Update on the Community Pandemic Support Group - We have over fifty volunteers, (this includes seven befrienders), the majority living within the parish. The selection of volunteers, tends to be based upon the geography of the person who has requested the help and regular callers tend to be paired with the same volunteer whenever possible. Over thirty volunteers are being called upon on a daily basis to provide the service. Some of the volunteers have developed direct contact with the clients, and are providing a regular service to them.

Due to the kindness of some of our volunteers, we are able to deliver the service to people who live outside the parish. Boots pharmacy in Caton and the Queen Street Medical practice continue to recommended people to use the service. People are so appreciative of the service and cannot thank everyone enough.

During the past six weeks the service has delivered: -

- Over 130 prescriptions have been collected and delivered to people's homes
- More than 40 essential shopping trips have been made and delivered to homes
- Other requests for help and information

Special thanks goes to all of the volunteers for their help and support. They have been truly outstanding.

If you are struggling with shopping or prescription collection or have another problem and you don't know where to turn, we are here for you. Call us now, what are you waiting for?

LUNE VALLEY SWIFT GROUP

Having flown over 5,000 miles from southern Africa, our Swifts have now returned here to nest, some welcome news in difficult times.

These fabulous birds can be seen around the village from May to early August. They look a little like Swallows, but are larger with longer, crescent-shaped wings. They often fly at high speed around buildings in groups known as 'screaming parties', for reasons that become obvious the minute you spot them!

Swifts have been declining due to a lack of suitable cavities high up on buildings in which to nest, and so, with the help of local residents and the expertise of builder Andrew Hill, we have been working to install nest boxes on houses and community buildings around the village, including the Victoria Institute.

Over the coming months we may not be able to travel too far from home, but Swifts can be spotted from gardens or on local walks, with warm evenings a particularly good time to keep an eye on the sky. If you spot Swifts or are interested in installing a Swift nest box, please let us know. Help us to make sure these amazing birds remain a feature of our summer skies.

THE JOYS OF ELECTRIC BIKES & TRIKES.

Many of my friends are quite keen cyclists. In recent years more and more have been doing the previously unthinkable and have bought an electric bike. They have all been delighted that they are able to get to the top of the hills now without undue pressure on their knees and they can keep up with their friends.

A few years ago I had to abandon my bike because I kept falling off. I treated myself to an electric trike. Unless you have very strong legs, it is too hilly round here to manage a non electric trike. I had a very scarey half hour learning to concentrate on steering instead of balancing but once I got the hang of it I loved it.

Trikes are wider and heavier than bikes, more difficult to store and very difficult to transport but once you are used to them they feel much more stable. Cars tend to give them a wide birth. You have to peddle hard to get up hills but each push on the pedal takes you a bit further and faster and I can even climb up to the windmills and to Little Cragg. I don't like going fast. Coming down hill you can switch my motor to recharge and that really slows me down on steep hills.

People often ask me how far I can go on one charge. It all depends- on how steep the hills are and on how hard I pedal. If I pedal very hard I need less assistance. I have been 35 kilometers in hilly country on one battery. I now carry a back up battery if I go out for the day.

The trike comes into it's own in the better weather. Mine has been a great boon for exercise during the lockdown. If you would like to know more do stop me or phone Sue on 771559.

LUNE VALLEY PRE SCHOOL CENTRE – CLOSURE END OF SUMMER TERM

Our Pre School is a charity, run by trustees and largely funded by payments from Lancashire County Council through the government's free childcare scheme.

Over the last few years, the numbers of children attending Pre School have dropped and the costs have risen, and not been met by government childcare grants. For some years we have been running at a loss, and have survived by using up our savings. We hoped to build up the numbers of children and become viable once again. However it is now clear that we can't do this. Therefore the trustees have decided that the Pre School must close at the end of the summer term 2020 (21st July).

As we are a charity we have to go through a formal process in order to dissolve our organisation. A public meeting has to be held to ratify the decision to close, and local residents are invited to attend. It will be held on Monday 8 June at 7pm, either in the Victoria Institute or via video link. The trustees are so sorry that we haven't been able to keep our lovely Pre School going. We're really grateful to Anne-Marie, Sarah and Jordie who have worked so hard and cheerfully and created such a calm and happy place for the children.

The Methodist Society at Caton was created in 1799 with 15 members growing to 70 members by 1831, the cost of the land in which the chapel now stands was £20.00 and the Chapel opened in 1836.

In 1875 a gallery was erected at a cost of £135 the chapel was reopened on the 18th September 1875.

Before the present organ was installed in 1894 the instrumental music was supplied by a choir and a bass fiddle played by Richard Heaps.
