SYCAMORE ROAD REPAIRS - Lancashire Highways have had a meeting with Oakmere Homes to discuss remedial work to Sycamore Road after their building work. Unfortunately there are limits to what they can require the developers to do. Oakmere recognise that they have caused damage to the carriageway, kerbs and pavements outside no. 43 - the old turning area - and will put that right. But not the additional general wear and tear all the way through to Brookhouse Road. Disappointing. But thank you to the local people who supplied photos to help us make the case. The Parish Council is contacting Susie Charles, the Lancashire County Councillor for our area, to ask if Highways can undertake resurfacing the rest of Sycamore Road and Sycamore Crescent.

DRAINS AND RESURFACING - Our thanks to Lancashire County Council who have dealt with some problem drains on Moorside Road and on Littledale Road. It is good to have had some resurfacing done on Littledale Road. Please do keep reporting faults to Lancashire Highways - sometimes there is action as a result! After the two storms in February, do report any blockages you noticed.

BULL BECK CAR PARK - Lancaster City Council has greatly improved the surface of the car park in recent weeks (although there are still some holes). We're grateful to Councillor Joan Jackson who pushed for this to be done. And many thanks to Mick Jackson, who spent many hours picking up and bagging rubbish left at the car park.

B4RN HYPERFAST BROADBAND

The monthly cost of £30 for the B4RN service has never increased, something that can't be said for many broadband providers. Existing B4RN customers who took out a Vonage telephone service may be now able to save some money If you have had the Vonage service for over 10 months! Ring them now to qualify, the landline call option is reduced from £10.25 to £6.87, and the £16 tariff to £10.05. Just dial 150 from your Vonage phone, and choose option 3.

BROOKHOUSE NEWS - Welcome to new residents who have moved into the village who are planning to get connected to the B4RN network. If you live in certain areas in the south of Brookhouse you may be able to get connected. Please register at b4rn.org.uk/postcode-checker. You are responsible for getting the conduit across your garden by digging a small trench, we can advise on the best routes and fit the house kits ready for B4RN engineers to 'blow fibre' and carry out engineering work to get you a live fibre service.

A massive thank you once again to all who donated items for the community packing day and took time out on the Saturday to come and fill the boxes at church. I think it's fair to say that a good time was had by all. It is so rewarding to be involved in this project, and it's great to see people returning year after year having enjoyed it last time. We packed 399 boxes on the day and items we were not able to use in the boxes went to QES and Caton St Paul's to help the Lancaster Homeless as well as some going to Women's Refuge and International Aid.

Special thanks go to all the volunteers who picked up boxes from all over the North Lancashire area, as well as the checking and packaging team who checked the boxes here in Brookhouse Methodist Church (BMC) over a two week period, and who came from as far away as Settle, but also from within our own village as well as all the local churches.

Caton St Pauls School had a non uniform day to raise funds to buy items for their shoeboxes and the following week all the juniors visited BMC to pack the items into shoeboxes and learn about why some items can't be sent and why it is so important that we do these shoeboxes. As always the children had lots of questions to ask and thoroughly enjoyed their time packing boxes for less fortunate children.

The final number of boxes for the whole area was 1580 individual shoeboxes which were put into 150 cartons and loaded onto a lorry in BMC car park by more volunteers. The lorry left us to pick up from another centre in the north west and was then headed for The Ukraine (the same destination as last year!).

After a brief rest, it's nearly time to start preparing for the coming year. Due to reorganisation in Samaritans Purse we will not be checking boxes this year but we will still plan to host the packing day and be a drop off location for boxes in 2020. We do collect items all year round so if you have anything you can drop it off at BMC when it's open for activities (Cafe open Mon-Wed 9am -2pm) or call me to arrange. Please note however we can no longer send sweets or toothpaste due to customs regulations.
