JAPANESE KNOTWEED - Japanese Knotweed is an invasive weed which is fast-growing and has to be controlled so it doesn't damage surrounding plants and buildings. The Parish Council is aware that a small clump on Artlebeck Road, on Lancaster City Council land, has been found. Lancaster City Council is dealing with the problem. Eliminating Japanese Knotweed is the responsibility of the landowner. The number to phone for Lancaster City Council land is 582491 and for Lancashire County Council is 0300 123 6780. If it is on private land, the landowner should take professional advice on how to eradicate it.

FELL VIEW PLAY PARK - The zipwire is now working. Other minor repairs have been carried out recently. Please inform the Parish Clerk of any damage or breakages at the Play Park.

# HIMALAYAN BALSAM- VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

We are looking for volunteers to remove Himalayan Balsam along the banks of the River Lune.

Himalayan Balsam is a non-native, invasive, flowering plant which is flourishing along the River Lune. It grows in dense stands, shading out other flowers and reducing plant diversity. It has shallow roots and dies back in Winter leaving the ground bare and at risk of erosion.

We want to remove it by picking it, leaving the ground clear for native species to establish, these are deeper rooted and help to stabilize the river bank.

The first date for this is 21st July 2021. We will meet at Denny Beck car park, Halton at 10.30am, children welcome.

We will be joined by Louisa Blundell from Lune Rivers Trust, who will explain, the benefits of picking the balsam and the most effective method.

Please wear suitable clothing, long sleeved shirts and trousers and sturdy footwear to prevent possible scratches and stings. The balsam is not toxic.

If the forecast is for torrential rain the event will be postponed.

# **B4RN HYPERFAST BROADBAND**

B4RN IS HERE! - If you have not seen contractors in the village yet you soon will. B4RN expect the hard pavement dig through the village to take 5/6 months. They do their best to avoid any disruption but, with such a big project, there is bound to be some. We do apologise in advance for this but a full fibre, future proofed, 1Gb connected village will be worth it. Work starts in Caton then moves on to Brookhouse. Have you registered for a connection? Search "GETB4RN" and fill in the form if think you would like to be connected to some of the world's fastest broadband. It is most cost effective to get connected as B4RN work through the village.

B4RN are registered as a not-for-profit community benefit society. To keep costs down we, as householders and a village, are responsible for the connection from the pavement to the property. Volunteers are needed to help households get duct laid from the pavement to the house. Can you dig yours in and help a few neighbours with theirs? Then have a street party?

CATON - If you live in Caton and have questions or need more information the Caton Village B4RN Group meet in the Victoria Room, Victoria Institute every Monday evening at 8.00pm.

BROOKHOUSE - If you live in Brookhouse, drop in to Brookhouse Methodist Church fover on Tuesdays between 7pm and 9pm starting from 6th July. We will answer any questions and provide the kit needed to get your connection in. Subject to volunteer availability we may also be available 9am to noon Monday to Wednesday. If unmanned on these mornings, there will be some cards available for you to ask your questions and leave your details. Alternatively, you can email b4rn4bn@

We would urge anyone who wants B4RN now or at any time in the future to get your ducting in across your gardens now. Don't wait until you're near the end of a current contract with another provider. Whilst the help and advice is available now, do it now.

To support those who want to get a connection we are looking for a range of local contractors who will be paid to install duct across gardens and install house kits. If you are a local gardener, landscaper, electrician, or handy person please get in touch at contractors@b4rn.org.uk

#### STILL IN A CONTRACT WITH ANOTHER PROVIDER?

Connect + (Connect Plus) is now available for Caton and Brookhouse. If you're stuck in a contract that has 12 months or less to run, you can get B4RN service for only a £5 monthly tariff until your other deal runs out. Once your existing provider's contract ends, you'll move on to B4RN's standard tariff, currently £30 monthly.

How do I get the discounted rate?

1. Sign up for B4RN at b4rn.org.uk/getb4rn

2. Apply for Connect plus at b4rn.org.uk/connectplus and upload a copy of your existing broadband

3. Once your ducting is through your garden and house kit installed, your street constructed, and your property goes live and connected to B4RN, your discounted rate will be applied.

There will be a leaflet through your door and information available at the Victoria Institute, Brookhouse Methodist Church and through Facebook.
