WASTE BINS - The Parish Council has asked Lancaster City Council to replace the waste bin at the lay-by on Quernmore Road, and to install a new one on Littledale Road, near the access to Ravenscar. They are awaiting deliveries of new bins and we hope to see action soon.

MILLENNIUM WAY - Lancashire County Council has recently surveyed the trees along the Millennium Way and identified a large number showing signs of ash dieback. Plans for felling and replanting with other species are expected.

CATON UPDATE - The "hard dig" in Caton has been delayed due to permit issues to work on the main road. However, these should have been resolved and the last stages of the village underway. It is now expected that the hard dig will complete early to mid-November before moving on to Brookhouse.

Many properties in Caton are now live on hyper-fast full fibre broadband, with numbers increasing each month. The Institute is also live and received a free connection and receives free service. One of the benefits of B4RN being a "community benefit society".

It is still a good time to sign up at "GETB4RN" and get connected whilst B4RN are still busy in the village and the volunteer group active. However, the toby box is in the pavement at the edge of each property for people to take service at any time in the future.

The weekly Caton meetings are going to be in the Station Hotel at 8.00pm on Mondays starting 1st November.

BROOKHOUSE UPDATE - Call in at our weekly drop in sessions at the Black Bull every Tuesday between 7pm and 8:20pm to get your questions answered.

During a hold-up in Caton in October, the street contractors dug pavements in a few areas of the village. They then returned to Caton to finish up there and will hopefully have returned to Brookhouse by now to complete the works here by January. They will start in the south side of Brookhouse and then move onto the north side (Brookhouse Road being the dividing line). They will also dig along Brookhouse Road which is the main route to get all properties to the distribution cabinet near Artle Beck. Chapel Square and New Street works are planned for January.

We now have a dedicated contractor team who will dig your front garden for you and install the house kit in lieu of you receiving the Dig Grant . To take advantage of this, you must firstly have registered for the B4RN service at b4rn.org.uk/getb4rn and responded to any emails from B4RN and/or the Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS). This results in a funding voucher being issued. At this stage we can arrange for your garden to be dug by the team by emailing b4rn4bn@gmail.com.

Once you are live with the B4RN service in December/January, remember to respond to a further email from DCMS which will release the government funding to our project.

Thanks to those who have invested. You can still invest with a minimum investment of £100. See the B4RN website. Thanks also to all landowners who have generously allowed B4RN to pass through their land and to all the volunteers who made this happen!

WOULD YOU BE ABLE TO HELP YOUR NEIGHBOURS IN AN EMERGENCY?

Our Community Emergency Group needs additional coordinators. We particularly need support in the Caton Green, Littledale/Moorside area, and Forge Mill. Throughout Caton-with-Littledale and the area from Scarthwaite through Denny Beck into Lancaster we need younger people to get involved.

Our work has a number of different elements. During lockdown, we helped set up the community support scheme run from the Victoria Institute. In an emergency, we can staff the Victoria Institute so it can act as an centre for the village - there is a generator in case of a lengthy power cut. We have lists of useful people who can be of practical assistance in a community crisis, for instance by clearing fallen trees. Throughout the year, we advise people on how to prepare for an emergency, such as flooding. We keep in touch with Lancaster City Council, Lancashire County Council and other organisations to make sure they know about our needs, and to send information out locally to residents. We meet occasionally as a group, and try to attend training exercises run by Lancaster City Council together with the emergency services.
